*Call to Worship

(One) This is the season of holy waiting.

(All) We wait for the One who will tear open the heavens and come down to save us.

(One) We watch for the day when God's name will be made known among the nations.

(All) We wait in the shadows for the Light of the World to appear.

(One) Come let us walk in the light of God!

First Candle of Advent: Hope

(One) Watch and wait for Christ's coming! (All) We light candles of hope, peace, joy, and love, remembering the promises of God with prayer.

Light of the Hope Candle

(One) God of hope, out of death you bring life. Renew us in hope, so that we may be alert to the dawning of Christ's advent among us. (All) God of promise, God of hope, into our darkness come.

*Hymn (154) O Come, O Come, Emmanuel (1) O come, O come, Emmanuel, and ransom captive Israel, that mourns in lonely exile here, until the Son of God appear.

Responsive Psalm

Psalm 25:1-10

(One) To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul. O my God, in you I trust; do not let me be put to shame; do not let my enemies exult over me.

(All) Do not let those who wait for you be put to shame; let them be ashamed who are wantonly treacherous. Make me to know your ways, O LORD; teach me your paths.

(One) Lead me in your truth, and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all day long. Be mindful of your mercy, O LORD, and of your steadfast love, for they have been from of old.

(All) Do not remember the sins of my youth or my transgressions; according to your steadfast love remember me, for your goodness' sake, O LORD! (One) Good and upright is the LORD; therefore he instructs sinners in the way. He leads the humble in what is right, and teaches the humble his way.

(All) All the paths of the LORD are steadfast love and faithfulness, for those who keep his covenant and his decrees.

*Hymn (153) Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus (1) Come, thou long-expected Jesus, born to set thy people free; from our fears and sins release us; let us find our rest in thee. Israel's strength and consolation, hope of all the earth thou art; dear Desire of every nation, Joy of every longing heart.

(2) Born thy people to deliver, born a child and yet a king, born to reign in us forever, now thy gracious kingdom bring. By thine own eternal Spirit rule in all our hearts alone; by thine all-sufficient merit raise us to thy glorious throne.
